## **TICKETS**

Remember to bring your tickets with you. Everyone who attends must have a ticket. Tickets are non-refundable.

There is no re-admittance to Kirkstall Abbey, once you have left the site you will not be allowed to re-enter.

## **TIMES**

Gates open at 3pm. Event curfew is 10:30pm. Please check social media for artist set times. Please see page 2 for social media links.

## **TICKET SALES & COLLECTIONS**

The box office is located directly outside the entrance, via Abbey Road and will be open 2pm - 9.00pm.

## **ENTRY GATES**

## **GENERAL TICKET HOLDERS:**

All customers enter via Abbey Road. Please then follow the signs to the 'general admission' customer entrance to the right hand side.

## **ACCESS TICKET HOLDERS:**

Access customers - at the box office please collect the appropriate wristband for the access area you booked, this will match your ticket booking and cannot be exchanged for other areas.

Once entered via Abbey Road, Access guests must enter the grounds via the 'Access Entrance' to the left hand side of the box office.

## **PREMIUM TICKETS HOLDERS:**

Once entered via Abbey Road, preimum guests must enter the grounds via the 'Premium Entrance' to the left hand side of the box office.

Customers will be wristbanded at the gate, this wristband will allow customers access to the Premium area located in the Abbev's Cloister.

This area will also have its own premium bar, food, seating and toilets.

Please note, you cannot see the stage from the Premium section and you will need to return to the main area to enjoy the show.

## **ACCESS**

Kirkstsall Abbey is an outdoor greenfield site.
Attendees will need to travel across grassy terrain to access the viewing platforms and other areas of the event. Should we experience rain in the run-up to the events or on the day of the events the terrain could become muddy and harder to navigate, please come prepared for such conditions.

If you have pre-arranged accessible tickets please collect your accreditation at the box office before following the signs for the 'Access and Premium gate' to have your ticket scanned.

Please note that all tickets for the accessible ambulant seating area and the accessible viewing platform have now sold out.

### **BLUE BADGE PARKING**

Blue Badge Parking is located at the Abbey House Museum car park.

All Blue Badge parking has been booked in advance, if you have requested this in your access form you will also receive an email to confirm your place.

Our blue badge car park is now full for this event, we cannot take any further requests for parking at this time.

The Blue Badge Car Park will open at 2:30pm on show days, with last entry to the car park at 8:30pm. No vehicles can be left overnight.

Alternative parking is available and can be prebooked as below.

## **CUSTOMER CAR PARKING**

Customer car Parking is available at Abbey Walk and can be purchased here

Upon arrival you will be greeted by one of the team at which point you will need to present your parking ticket for scanning. We would advise you plan your journey in good time to avoid any delays.

Car park gates open at 2:30pm, with last entry to the car parks at 8:30pm. There is no overnight parking and vehicles will be towed.

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

Kirkstall Abbey is located approximately 4.4 miles from Leeds City centre with many public transport links.

Please use public transport or travel on foot wherever possible.

Kirkstall Abbey has 2 local train stations nearby; Kirkstall Forge is located approximately 1.3 miles from Kirkstall Abbey and Headingley Station is approximately 0.7 miles.

### **BAGS**

To support our staff and make this process efficient, please avoid bringing a bag if possible. Backpacks along with any bags over A3 size will not be permitted. There are no cloakroom facilities at Kirkstall Abbey.

## NO CAMERAS OR TAPE RECORDERS

Please do not bring any kind of recording equipment, drones or remote control devices as these will not be permitted within the venue. There is no facility for storing confiscated equipment. Entry to the event may be refused. All persons entering the venue consent to any photography/filming/recording as arranged by the organiser.

#### **VIEWING**

This is a standing event. Please do not bring any picnic blankets, chairs or portable furniture, inflatable or otherwise. These will be confiscated at the gates.

## **REFRESHMENTS**

There will be a number of food and drink vendors, catering for all tastes.

Food and drink is not permitted into the venue unless it is for medical purposes. Any food and drink required for medical purposes must be arranged in advance. Please email access@futuresoundgroup.com to arrange.

There are water points available on site and free drinking water is also available at the bars. Customers are entitled to bring in 1 x 500ml empty reusable water bottle (plastic only).

## **CARD PAYMENTS**

Kirkstall Abbey is completely cashless and there are no cash points inside the venue, so please plan ahead.
